

Progress in Rockford





The restoration of our largest building — the W.P. Dobson Store/Masonic Lodge — is proceeding with new flooring, doors and windows. Flooring and the staircase for the north side porch will follow. Historic restoration specialist Jason Allen is doing the work, using some materials from other historic restoration projects of the same period. He also has completed a renovation assessment plan for our other remaining project, the Mark York Tavern. With the right plan in place, the tavern could once again become one of Rockford's most prominent structures!
